

Color Code Program

If you have been placed in the in the Color-Code Random Urinalysis Program as a condition of your pretrial services supervision. The procedures of the program are described below.

You will be assigned one of various colors - for example, Red, Yellow, Purple, Brown, etc.

You are to call our office every Sunday through Thursday between 6:00 p.m. and 8:00 a.m. at **(401) 752-7375** to obtain the color for the next day. If the color matches your assigned color, you are to report to the U.S. Probation Office, Providence for the following day between 8:30 a.m. and 4:00 p.m. and be prepared to provide a fresh, clean, unadulterated and undiluted specimen. An inability to provide a sample will be looked at as a refusal to provide a sample.

You must provide to the collector at the time you report to the probation office, copies of any prescriptions and/or over the counter drugs you have taken in the two weeks prior to the specimen. Your urine will be tested for drugs and/or alcohol.

Please be advised that if your urine specimen tests positive for a controlled substance that was not prescribed to you, or you attempt to tamper with the collection procedure or ingest a substance in an attempt to alter the results of the test, it will be considered a violation of your supervision and may be reported to the Court. Possible responses include increased urine surveillance, verbal/written reprimands, referral to substance abuse treatment, a modification of your conditions, or revocation of your release.
